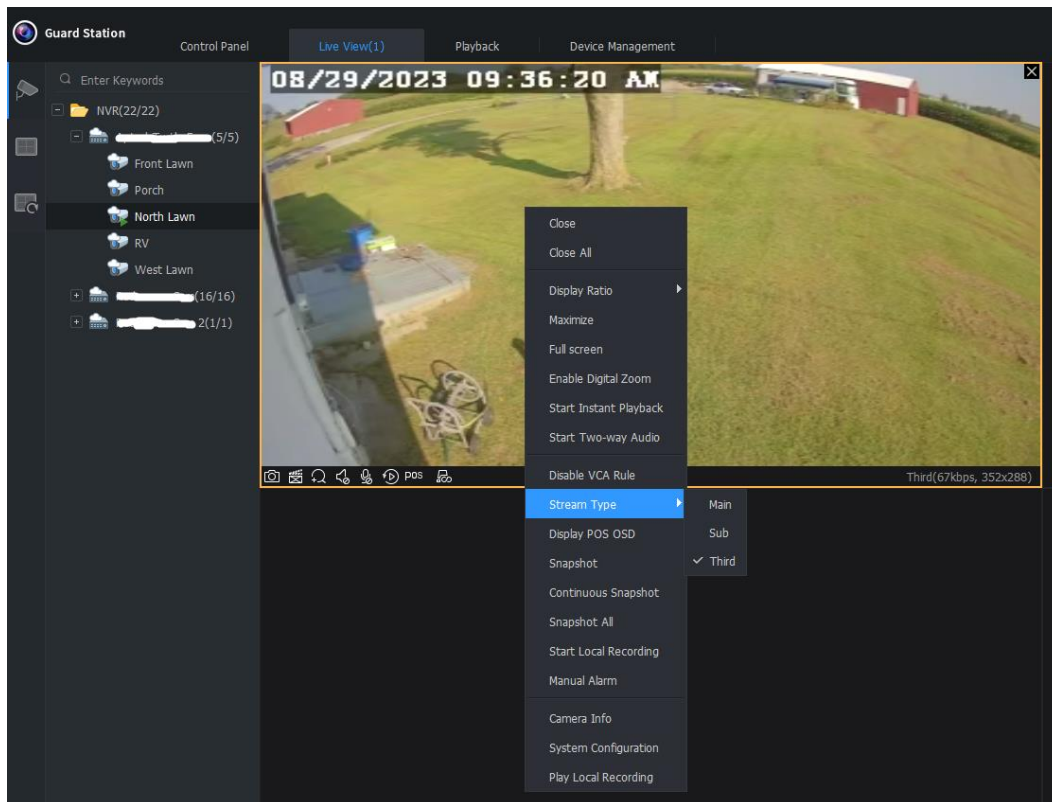


Guard Station 64-bit

How to change resolution to increase PC performance

1. Run Guard Station:
 - a. Double click the Guard Station icon, and enter your credentials (if prompted).
 - b. Open the camera(s) you wish to display.
2. Change the Stream of each camera:
 - a. Right click each camera, and select Stream Type.
 - b. Make sure each camera is check-marked for either 'Sub' or 'Third'. If it isn't, select 'Third.'
 - c. INFO: The 'Main' stream setting provides the best quality image, but uses the most computer resources. Changing cameras to Sub or Third uses a fraction of the resources and should increase PC performance.
 - d. If you save a view, it will save the current Stream Type settings. Setting too many cameras to 'Main' can greatly decrease PC performance.



3. Also note: PC performance is directly related to the software used, and the components of the computer itself. For example, a newer version of Windows or other software often requires better computer hardware for optimal performance.

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
